3. Oppressed (broken) by sin, Ps.51:17

Most are 'unbroken'

#### 1. Sin breaks hearts, Ps.51:17

2 Sm. 12, 13 / 18

- 2. Sin binds habits, 2 Pt.2:14
- 3. Sin banishes hopes, Ro.7:24
- Consequences: separation, Is.59:1-2
- Cost: cross, Is.53:10
- Cure: 2 Co.7:8-10

Worldly sorrow:
Sin hurt me

Godly sorrow:
I hurt God

Broken spirit . . . Contrite heart characteristics of true repentance Judas (remorse) . . . Peter, Lk.22:62

- Consequences: separation, Is.59:1-2
- Cost: cross, Is.53:10
- Cure: 2 Co.7:8-10
- Comfort from sin: Ps.34:18; Mt.12:20

A bruised reed He will not break, And smoking flax He will not quench, Till He sends forth justice to victory

#### Mt.12:20, broken / bruised reed

- Bruised / broken reed is bowed
- Jesus did not trample on weak to gain His ends
- He cares for those bowed down in sin, Mt.9:36; 11:28
- Final triumph belongs to Him and His gospel

Isa.61:1 – bandage brokenhearted

Lk.4:18 – oppressed (break...)

# Lk.18:13-14, good man lost, bad man saved?

The good man looked . . .

- 1. Over the area; got close to Temple
- 2. Around; stood with 'holy' people
- 3. Down on pitiful sinner from afar
- 4. Inside and rejoiced in what he saw
- 5. Outside himself and cried for attention, praise

Lk.18:13-14, good man lost, bad man saved?

The bad man looked . . .

- 1. Over the area; away from Temple
- 2. Around; away from 'holy' people
- 3. Down because of shame (Ezr.9:6)
- 4. Inside, repulsed by what he saw
- 5. Outside himself and cried to God for mercy. NO excuses; no blame...

#### Effects of broken heart

- God: impossible to serve Him too much; no task too lowly. 1 Jn.4:19
- Sinners: Ex.32; Lk.19
- Brothers: Mt.18
