B. We ALL have a Problem with this!!

- 1. 1 John 1:8 "If we say that we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us."
- 2. Roman 3:23 "for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God,"

D. Sin Kills the Church!!

- 1. Acts 20:17-38 Paul warned them of the danger
- 2. 1 Corinthians 5 "Do you not know that a little leaven leavens the whole lump?"
- 3. Revelation 2-3 5 of the 7 churches of Asia were condemned for allowing Sin to exist!

- 2. This is a favorite tactic!
 - Matthew 7:15 "Beware of false prophets, who come to you in sheep's clothing, but inwardly they are ravenous wolves.
 - 2 Cor 11:13-14 For such are false apostles, deceitful workers, transforming themselves into apostles of Christ. And no wonder! For Satan himself transforms himself into an angel of light.
- 3. We must see through the <u>Disguise!</u> 2 Thess 5:21-22

B. Sin Deceives by **Minimizing!**

 - a. "yes, it sin, but it is not that bad"
 - b. "yes, it is technically wrong...but it won't hurt anybody"
 - c. "we will just change this ONE thing"

- 2. This has Never excused Lawlessness!
 - a. Genesis 4 Cain...it was still a sacrifice...
 - b. Leviticus 10:1ff Nadab & Abihu...it was still fire...
 - c. 1 Sam 15 Saul killed most of the Amalekites...
- 3. ALL SIN WILL KILL!
 - <u>James 2:10</u> For whoever shall keep the whole law, and yet stumble in one point, he is guilty of all.

 - a. "we can do so much good"
 - b. "it will bring people in"
 - c. "well I think God won't mind"

- 2. Rationalization has been tried before and FAILED!
 - a. 1 Samuel 13:1-8 Samuel was a week late, Saul sacrificed
 - b. 2 Samuel 6 Uzzah touched the ark
 - c. 2 Samuel 24 David numbered his Army
- 3. There is NEVER any excuse for Sin!
 - a. It is never right to do wrong!
 - b. Isa 55:8-9 "For as the heavens are higher than the earth, So are My ways higher than your ways...

D. Sin Deceives by **Glamorizing!**

- 1. Sin Tries to Look Beautiful
 - a. "it will be fun or wonderful"
 - b. "you're cool or grown up if you do this..."

D. Sin Deceives by **Glamorizing!**

- 2. Numerous Bible Examples...

 - b. 2 Sam 11 Bathsheba was appealing to David
- 3. The Horrors of a Hell will Cure this!
 - <u>Revelation 21:8</u> "But the cowardly, unbelieving, abominable, murderers, sexually immoral, sorcerers, idolaters, and all liars shall have their part in the lake which burns with fire and brimstone, which is the second death."

- 2. Compromising with Sin always Corrupts Truth!
 - The sheep that compromises with the wolf will be eaten! Matthew 7:15, Acts 20:29-31
 - Can one Mix LIGHT and DARK without diminishing the LIGHT? Jn 3:18-21, Mt 6:22-24
- 3. There Is **NEVER** any Compromising on Truth

- b. Many Snares today...Alcohol/Drugs, Immorality, Covetousness, false teaching, FEAR!
