Hindrances To Prayer

Retreating armies cut into / broke up road behind them – *hindered*

- Ac.24:4 But so that I may not 'delay' you any further...
- 1 Th.2:18 Therefore we wanted to come to you—even I, Paul, time and again—but Satan 'hindered' us.
- Gal.5:7 You ran well. Who 'hindered' you from obeying the truth?
- <u>1 Pt.3:7</u> . . .That your prayers may not be 'hindered.'

What if we lost privilege of prayer?

- Remember many times we neglected it?
- What hinders our prayers?

James 1, the doubter

But let him ask in faith, with no doubting, for he who doubts is like a wave of the sea driven and tossed by the wind. For let not that man suppose that he will receive anything from the Lord... -Ja.1:6-7

- Faith-filled prayer rests on two bases -
 - 1. God is Almighty; hears us. Job 38
 - 2. God is Love. 1 Jn4:8; Ro.8:32

- God answers prayer according to our eternal needs, not necessarily our earthly wants
 - No' Mt.20:22
 - Not now' Ro.1:9, 13; 15:32. Ac.28
 - Answer yes, then no Mt.18
 - Answer no, then yes Moses; Lazarus
 - Give more than we ask for 1 K.3
 - Give other than we ask for Dt.3:23-27. 2 Co.12

The 'wrong way' illustrated

- 1. Ask God to work miracles. Hb.2:2-4.
- 2. Ask God to save lost without obedience.

Sthough He was a Son, yet He learned obedience by the things which He suffered. And having been perfected, He became the author of eternal salvation to all who obey Him – Hb.5.

Common misunderstandings about prayer

- 1. God is unchangeable, so prayer has no effect. [1 Pt.3:12]
- 2. Omniscient God knows our needs before we ask. [Ja.5:16]
- 3. God cannot answer prayers without miracles. [Ja.5:17-18]
- 4. Reflex influence is the only benefit of prayer. [1 K.18. Ja.5; 1:5]
