 - Root of other vices

 - True love, not selfishness
 - Self-denial, not indulgence, Mt.16

2: lovers of money: avaricious

- Lk.16:14
- Prosperity is more dangerous than poverty

3: unloving: hard-hearted, unfeeling, without regard for others

- Abortions
- Child abuse, neglect
- Euthanasia

4: lovers of pleasure: crowds out love for God. Hb.11:25

5: form of godliness

- 1. Professed Christians
- 2. Greatest enemy: not atheists, but hypocrites religious rebels
