Ark Of Covenant Corrects God's Critics

1-2 Samuel

Three arks

- Noah: Gn.6-9
- Moses: Ex.2
- Covenant: only furniture in holy of holies
 - -Acacia wood overlaid with gold
 - -Cover: 'mercy seat' and cherubim
 - -'Lost'

I. God Cannot Be Dominated

1 Sam.4:1-3 Blackmail:

- 'God, glorify your Name: give us victory or Philistines will get ark!'
- Reply: 'I'll glorify My Name by giving you defeat' (4:10-11, 18-22).
 - o God warned them, 2:12-17, 22-25
 - Thought they could 'use' God

If one turns away his ear from hearing the law, even his prayer is an abomination – Pr.28:9

Joshua 6 – good luck?


- Idolaters carried idols to battle.

- Ep.5:5, idolatry: alive and well in Ephesus

- 2. Tumors, 6-12
 - ►Once they got what they wanted, they didn't want what they got
 - ► Would give anything to return it, 6:1-12
 - God will not suffer defeat,
 Ps.2:1-4

- 19, ignorance and irreverence
 - Nu.1:50-54
 - Slaughter vindicated God

Philistine cart showed honor.

Judgment began at house of God;

they knew better.

1 Sam.6:13-21

- Irony: died by mercy seat
- Greatest blessing → greatest danger ...because of irreverence
- Men still desecrate holy things
 - **1.** Bible. Mk.7:13
 - 2. Lord's day. Ac.20:7
 - 3. Worship.
 - 4. Marriage vows.
 - 5. Prayer.

Fatal flaws . . .

- 1) New cart, 3. Nu.4:8...15
- 2) Good intentions, 4-5
- 3) Progress, 6
- 4) Did God a favor, 6-7
- 5) Ignorance (no excuse), 9
 - Trivializes God to ignore His law
 - > Ac.21
 - Burning building

Is sincerity enough? Sincerity never changes truth

A thing is never right just because we believe it is so.

A thing is right only if God's word says so.

- 1) Gn.27, Isaac: Jacob is Esau
- 2) Gn.37, Jacob: Joseph is dead
- 3) Ac.26:9, Paul: ought to persecute
- 4) 'Have it your way'??

2 Sam.6:12-23

- Gladness (12): why? 1 Chr.15, truth
- Undignified (15-16, 20-23)
 - -Should imitate Saul's pride, false dignity?
 - -'It was before God' David did not care what others thought

Lukewarmness is blasphemy 'God doesn't excite us!'

- Mt.21:14-16, Jewish leaders upset
- Ac.3:7-8, excited over healing
