- 'Resolved' placed on his heart
 - -Made up his mind
 - Resolved to do right
 - The heart is the . . .

Intellect: knew truth (Josiah, Jeremiah...)

Emotions: heart wanted to obey God. Ac.2:37

Will: determined to do it; personal resolve. Pr.4:23

- Would not defile himself (period!)
- Surrounded by immorality, idolatry yet remained pure

Satan cannot conquer one who says no and means it

- 'Innocent' things can lead to sin.
 - -Why court trouble over food???
 - Not always a little thing: Gn.3
 - -We have to eat. When in Rome...
 - Lv.11, kosher foods

Daniel's Purpose, 8 Daniel's Purity, 8 Daniel's Provisions, 8

- Daniel's food was . . .
 - Prepared by Gentiles.
 - -Sacrificed to 'gods'? Ex.34:15
 - -Undiluted wine?

Wine is a mocker, Strong drink is a brawler, And whoever is led astray by it is not wise – Pr.20:1.

Poured as libation on altars

Took courage. Jer.39:6-7

Conviction requires sacrifice
