# WARNING on 'New Hermeneutics'

#### 1. What is Hermeneutics?

- a. <u>Dungan</u>: "the science of interpretation...the scripture"
- b. <u>Webster</u>: "the study of the methodical principles of interpretation"
- c. <u>Am. Heritage</u>: "the theory and methodology of interpretation, especially of scripture"

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- 2. The Lord's church holds to a method of Biblical interpretation used & demanded by the Bible itself!
  - a. All Scripture is God Breathed! 2 Tim 3:16-17
  - b. Commands, Examples, Necessary Inference; Biblical patterns, definitions, silence all establish <u>Bible Authority</u>!

# I. <u>Biblical Hermeneutics...</u>

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1. Romans 1:16-17 - For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ, for it is the power of God to salvation for everyone who believes, for the Jew first and also for the Greek. For in it the righteousness of God is revealed from faith to faith; as it is written, "The just shall live by faith." GOD'S STANDARD

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- 2. 2 Tim 3:16-17 All Scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness, that the man of God may be complete, thoroughly equipped for every good work. ALL FROM GOD, ALL WE NEED!

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3. 2 Peter 1:2-3 - Grace and peace be multiplied to you in the knowledge of God and of Jesus our Lord, as His divine power has given to us all things that pertain to life and godliness, through the knowledge of Him who called us by glory and virtue, COMPLETE MANUAL

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- 4. Jude 1:3 Beloved, while I was very diligent to write to you concerning our common salvation, I found it necessary to write to you exhorting you to contend earnestly for the faith which was once for all delivered to the saints. TIMELESS

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5. Rev 22:18-19 - For I testify to everyone who hears the words of the prophecy of this book: If anyone adds to these things, God will add to him the plagues that are written in this book; and if anyone takes away from the words of the book of this prophecy, God shall take away his part from the Book of Life, from the holy city, and from the things which are written in this book.

- 6. These passages DEMAND a Careful, methodical, bottom-up approach to handling Scripture!!

#### B. We use the same methods used by NT Brethren!

- 1. Biblical Authority was /is established by:
  - Commands Jn 14:15, 1 Cor 14:37
  - Examples Phil 3:17, 4:9
  - Necessary Inference Acts 2:42, 20:7, 1 Cor 16:1-2

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- 2. Question: Gentiles & Elements of the Old Law Acts 15
  - Commands Acts 15:7,15
  - Examples Acts 15:8-12
  - Necessary Inference Acts 15:19

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- 1. "we must take responsibility for <u>deciding what in</u>
  <u>Scripture is worthy of belief today</u>. All such judgments are <u>relative to our own</u> social location, interests, needs, life-history, and general outlook on things."
- 2. Some forward that we must "interpret the Bible in context of <u>modern</u> culture; and allow <u>scientific thought</u> to control our understanding of the Bible." aka <u>Cultural</u> <u>Reinterpretation!</u>

#### B. Quotes & concepts from some in the Church!

- 1. "I am strongly of the opinion that the entire field of how to establish Bible Authority needs a complete restudy. The way we have gone at it results in a narrow, divisive legalism that is totally non-biblical."
- 2. The NT is not a pattern or blueprint that must be followed.
- 3. The NT does not teach us by apostolic examples or necessary inferences. Christ alone is our model for teaching
- 4. "We should study the life of Jesus and do what we feel He would do in the circumstances."

#### C. Examples of 'New' Hermeneutics...

- The Bible needs to be interpreted via Modern Standards
- The Bible is not law, but God's <u>Loving Ideas</u>.
- The New Testament is <u>not a Pattern</u> to Follow.
- ➤ Bible Examples are nonbinding and do not need to be Followed.
- ➤ It is not so much if you follow the Bible specifically, divine acceptance is based your intentions & feelings.

#### D. Results of New Hermeneutics...

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#### 2. The Bible is Written for <u>ALL TIME</u>!

- The Bible establishes THE standard of conduct for all times! We must conform to it!! Rom 12:1-3, 8:29
- God does not Change, and neither does His word Heb 13:8,9

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#### 1. Word Says:

- 1 Cor 14:37 If anyone thinks himself to be a prophet or spiritual, let him acknowledge that the things which I write to you are the commandments of the Lord.
- 2 Thess1:7-8 "...when the Lord Jesus is revealed from heaven with His mighty angels, in flaming fire taking vengeance on those who do not know God, and on those who do not obey the gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ.
- Jn 12:48 "He who rejects Me, and does not receive My words, has that which judges him the word that I have spoken will judge him in the last day.

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- 2. The NT is Loving...but it is our Law!
  - The NT is the Perfect law James 1:25
  - We are to be obedient James 2:10, Jn 14:15
  - Jn 15:10 "If you keep My commandments, you will abide in My love, just as I have kept My Father's commandments and abide in His love.

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- 2 Tim1:13 "Hold fast the pattern of sound words which you have heard from me,..."
- 1 Peter 2:21 "For to this you were called, because Christ also suffered for us, <u>leaving us an example, that you should follow His steps</u>:"

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#### 2. It is commanded...to follow examples!

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#### 2. Emotions are important, but God wants Obedience!

- Paul I have lived in all good conscience before God until this day." Acts 23:1
- Zech 7:1-7 Did you really do these things for Me...Should you not have obeyed the words of the Lord...
