Why is Moses angry? He fears more judgment.

Aaron explains: not rebellion but fear of doing wrong (presumption).

Aaron esteems God's law.

God spares them.

<sup>9</sup> The daughter of any priest, if she profanes herself by playing the harlot, she profanes her father. She shall be burned with fire.

### 4. The 'second sin': Lv.10:16-18

<sup>3</sup> 'Whoever of all your descendants throughout your generations, who goes near the holy things which the children of Israel dedicate to the LORD, while he has uncleanness upon him, that person shall be cut off from My presence: I am the LORD. <sup>4</sup> 'Whatever man of the descendants of Aaron, who is a leper or has a discharge, shall not eat the holy offerings until he is clean. And whoever touches anything made unclean by a **corpse...** – Leviticus 22. [Cf. Nu.9:6; Mt.5:23-24]

# III. What About 'Baptism Without Teaching'?

### **Proof: illustration**

'A pill works; we don't know how or why. Same true of baptism'

Purpose:
