What will it profit a man...? Mt.16:26

- Cross: instrument of death, 21-24

 Two crosses: as He...so we
 Total commitment
- Paradoxes, 24-25
 - -Self gains only when self loses
 - -We lose by gaining, gain by losing

What will it profit a man...? Mt.16:26

- What can repay a man for losing his life and leave him with a profit (26)?
- If he loses real life, how can he profit even if he gains the world?

1. Search for meaning (wisdom), 1:16,18

- Universities cannot answer
 - -Socrates
- Physicist J. Robert Oppenheimer

2. Ignorance (madness / folly), 1:17

- "Ignorance is bliss"
- "What you don't know can't hurt you"
- Bury head in sand...

3. Pleasure, 2:1

- Solomon's self-indulgence. Lk.15
 –Lord Byron
- God made us to enjoy life on basis of spiritual things

4. Happiness, 2:2

 Dennis Wholey: Are You Happy?
 – Perhaps only twenty percent of Americans are happy

'Happiness is an imaginary condition, formerly attributed by the living to the dead, now usually attributed by adults to children and by children to adults'

Thomas Szasz

4. Happiness, 2:2

- 'Everyone has the right to be happy, and I propose to claim that right'
- 'God wants (me) to be happy'

5. Wine, 2:3

- Fraternities / Sororities / Commercials
- Teenagers between ages 12 17 who say they drink heavily (five or more drinks on five or more occasions in the past month):
- 77 percent had at least one serious problem related to drinking in the past year
- 63 percent had built up tolerance to the effects of alcohol
- 20 percent reported psychological problems related to their drinking
- 12 percent reported health problems . . .

6. Ruling an Empire, 2:4

• Ps.127:1

Unless the Lord builds the house, They labor in vain who build it; Unless the Lord guards the city, The watchman stays awake in vain

7. Nature, 2:5-6

- In all his gardens he could not grow the tree of life or the plant of contentment
- We must choose God or pantheism

8. Authority, 2:7

• Wm. Tweed, boss of Tammany Hall

9. Possessions, 2:7-8

Riches do not profit in the day of wrath, But righteousness delivers from death – Pr.11:4.

The problem with possessions:
1) Dictate. Cost us precious time...
2) Die. 1 Jn.2:15-17
3) Disappoint. Hag.1:5-6

10. Entertainment, 2:8

 There is NO perfect, permanently satisfying song or pleasure

11. Immorality, 2:8

- Many "concubines" NASB; ESV... "Harem" – NIV
- 1 K.1:1-4

12. Greatness, 2:9

• Alexander the Great conquered every enemy... except one

Evaluation – What Was The Profit?

- 2:11, all was vanity! False advertising.
- 2:12, Loser; no profit.
 - -Solomon: great mind, vast resources
 - If he found no satisfaction when he had the whole world to ransack, how much hope for common men to find it in small assets and less knowledge?

What Was The Profit?

• 2:13-15, no satisfaction.

Could not escape death, vanity, or vexation of spirit.

- 2:16, greatest man of his day... forgotten. Sad legacy
- 2:17-20, despair. What's the use?

What's The Use?

- 21, *LOSING*. Lk.12:20
- 22, GETTING. Rat race
- 23, *KEEPING*. 'Take it with us'??

⁴¹And Jesus answered and said to her, "Martha, Martha, you are worried and troubled about many things. ⁴²But one thing is needed, and Mary has chosen that good part, which will not be taken away from her" – Luke 10
