Life is short, 1-2

A LORD B You have been our dwelling place **C** In all generations D Before the mountains E Were brought forth E' Or ever You had formed D' The earth and the world C' Even from everlasting to everlast. B' You are Δ'

I shall 'return' (v.3)

• Gn.3:19

In the sweat of your face you shall eat bread Till you return to the ground, For out of it you were taken; For dust you *are*, And to dust you shall return

Dust: pulverized. Another generation takes his place.

It flew by! (4)

- 1000 years...like yesterday
- Like a watch in the night Whoosh! (5-6)
- Flood...dream...grass

Grass: sown, grown, blown, mown, gone...

-2 Pt.3:8

Like a sigh (7-9)

- Few days, full of trouble, Job 14:1
- Life: `a little gleam of time between two eternities' – Carlyle

I'll fly away (10)

• 70 - 80

May boast of quantity, not necessarily quality, of life Make the most of life (12a)

- Teach us to number our days...
 - -Cannot number stars or sand
 - Number our days: realize how few they are
 - -70 years: 365 days x 70 = 25,550

Don't put it off (12b)

- Do not procrastinate
 - -Ps.39:4, frail: transient; fleeting life; 5, handbreadth...vapor
 - •1 Sm.20:3, a step
 - •Ac.24, Felix
 - -Pr.27:1, tomorrow
 - -Mt.25:1-13, when time ran out
