

Grow! A present tense command

- 1 Pt.2:2, like a baby
- 1. How? 2 Pt.1:2, 5-8, 11
- 2. Why? 2 Pt.3:17

Carried away, cause one to go astray in unbelief.

Knowledge is theme word of 2 Peter (1:5; 2:20; 3:18)

We grow in His favor as we grow in obedient knowledge of Christ

 Those who quit growing are infants: exposed to dangers, disease, death

Child without discipline: delinquent.

Child grows by accepting graceful gifts of parents (food, clothing, med. care...)

God places great importance on truth and sound doctrine. 2 Pt.1:12

Established in present truth (2 Pt.1:12)

Fix firmly in a place -BDAG.

Cause someone to become stronger in the sense of more firm and unchanging in attitude or belief -L-N.

- Who grows without time and effort?
- Labor of love is joy, not labor
- We grow as much as we want. Mt.5:6
- Mt.25, given grace...

Established in present truth

You therefore, my son, be strong in the grace that is in Christ Jesus – 2 Tim.2:1

- Our faith, hope, love either grows or shrinks.
- If it grows, it changes us.

Grace that saves from sin also sanctifies



Lord: Authority, power, rule; of eternal significance

Best indicator of spiritual growth: way we live

We grow in grace by daily <u>learning</u> His will and <u>living</u> the virtues in the Word

2 Co.13:5, Examine yourselves as to whether you are in the faith. Test yourselves. Do you not know yourselves, that Jesus Christ is in you?—unless indeed you are disqualified.

Our spiritual examination is . . .

- 1. Inward: spiritual attitude / actions. 1 Sm.2:26.
- 2. Outward: unselfishness, good works, teach others, love brethren. 2 Th. 1:3.
- 3. Upward: steadfast desire to please God. 2 Co.5:9.
- 4. Downward: rooted, established in Christ, like well-rooted tree. Col.2:7.
