Criminal negligence

- Neither ignorance of the people nor negligence of the preacher will spare lives
- God warns sinners through the watchman
 - ¹Without the warning, they die, 33:4 (Ep.2:12)
 - ²Blood on watchman's hands, 3:18 (Ac.18:6; 20:26-27)

Blood

- 3:18, habitual sinner, not warned: blood also on watchman
- 3:19, habitual sinner, warned: blood on own head
- 3:20, righteous man, not warned: blood also on watchman
- 3:21, righteous man, warned: blood on own head
