

Friendship of the world is NOT:
1. Being friendly with people of the world, Lk.15:1-2
2. Enjoying innocent pleasures, 1 Tim.6:17

James 4:4 1 Jn.2:15-17

"But God gave us these things" Many ignore God – give priority to His blessings. Mt.6:24

James 4:4 1 Jn.2:15-17 **1 Jn.5:19** World <u>'lies in</u>' the evil one

- World lies in [the power of] the evil one – NASB; ESV...
- World lies [under the sway of] the evil one – NKJV
 - Passive: under satan's control
 - No struggle to escape

Often think of Gal.5:19-21

- 'Respectable worldliness' often leads to more flagrant types.
 - Mt.13:22, not lasciviousness, but still worldly.
- As society declines, 'immoral' worldliness (Ga.5) becomes more respectable – society feeds the monster.

Immodest dress: ¹slights God 1 Tim.2:9-10 'But what is modest / immodest?' *If you don't know, better find out

The world admits what some Christians do not

*Cause & effect: tale of two sinners

Weak eats, defiles conscience; harmless act; heart of sinner. V.11...13

Strong leads him to defile conscience. 'I didn't intend to make him sin.'

*Sincere people, innocent actions, commit sin

*Cause & effect: tale of two sinners

Dress modestly; someone lusts. Result: 1 sinner

Dress immodestly; leads someone to lust. Result: 2 sinners
