- NT churches try to bring people into spiritual adulthood
- Many passages tell them to behave like little children

- 36-37: non-citizen, lowest of lowly, but headed for heaven

²Malice, 1 Co.14:20

- Evil; maliciousness; ill-will.
- Paul speaks as father (4:15) to children
 - As Mt.18: grownups to imitate children

³Imitation, Ep.5:1, His likeness

- 'Therefore' ← 4:31-32
- What would the Father do?
- Partakers of divine nature, 2 Pt.1:4

Imitation, Mt.5:43-48, His love

Imitation, Ph.2:15, His light

⁴Obedience, Ep.6:1-3

- Children obey and honor
- 'Obedience' without understanding: blind zeal
- Apathy after understanding: lukewarm ingratitude

⁵Dependence, 1 Tim.5:8

- Mt.18:25
- We think child must receive kingdom as adult (obey gospel as we do)
 - Here: child sets pattern from man
 - Total trust
- Mt.11:25, babes
