# III. Right Reaction To God's Power

- No doubt about it (34, 38)
- Maiden of Nazareth has more faith than priest in holy place
- Maiden believes far more startling message than Zacharias

## No sign (36-37)

- Mary does not ask for a sign
- Mary receives more gracious sign than Zacharias

Elizabeth shows (again) that an impossible birth is possible

## Mary, the believer (38)

- Mary believes incredible message
- Mary accepts consequence of promise
- Mary submits to God

## Mary, the believer (38)

- Mary believes incredible message
- Mary accepts consequence of promise
- Mary submits to God Maidservant (maid-<u>slave</u>)
  - 'Let it be to me according to Your word'
    - 1. Ready to do His will (22:42)
    - 2. Relationship (Mt.1:19)
    - 3. Risk life (Dt.22:23-24)
    - 4. Reputation (Ph.2:7)
