 We MUST understand words to understand text.

# Neighbors read / study together Mk.1:1-15

- 'Teaches us to be baptized; immersion'
- 'No; should be baptized with Holy Spirit'
- 'To me: slow down; go to woods; meet God'
- 'God told me: will send HS to me as a dove'
  - -'I don't think so'
    - 'You're disagreeing with God'
- 'This shows how rich the Bible is: it can mean so many things'

# Words are elements of the sentence

- We MUST understand words to understand text.
  - -Mk.14:26, Mount of Olives??
  - -Mk.1 -
    - Passage fulfills prophecy (Is.40)
    - Preachers sent to world (Mk.16; Mt.28). Ac.1:4-5; Ac.2
    - Place provides enough water for baptism (Jn.3:23)

 Matter of demonstration, not discussion. Ac.2, 3, etc.

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   -Focus is <u>baptizers</u>, not subjects

- 9-10: Holy Spirit [Dove] identified Jesus: Son of God, Jn.1:29-34
- 'Gospel' (1): "good news only once"
- 'Repentance' (4, 15). Vine

# Sentence: group of words forming a complete thought Things to look for –

- Connectors. AS (2); AND (4); FOR (4)
   FOR (16); THEREFORE (2:28)
- Main verbs: 4, came; 5, went, were bap.
- Subject: 4, John; 5, land of Judea...
- Object: 3, prepare WAY OF LORD
- Prepositions: 5, TO him; BY him; IN Jordan
- Sentence: 13

#### Con-text

'The parts of a sentence, paragraph, discourse, etc. that occur just before and after a specified word or passage, and determine its exact meaning'

- To believe something without regard for context is unsafe.
- To believe something that conflicts with context is false.

### Context

- Thayer: lexicon (Grimm's Wilke's) 1886
- Grenfell-Hunt, 1896 Egyptian papyri
- Adolf Deissmann not 'Holy Ghost Gk.'
  - koinē (common) language of Greek world
- YET: 1 Co.16:1-2 Thayer rightly defined 'collection' without proof from ancient writers

### Context

<sup>1</sup>Now concerning the <u>collection</u> for the saints, as I have given orders to the churches of Galatia, so you must do also: <sup>2</sup>On the first day of the week let each one of you lay something aside, storing up as he may prosper, that there be no <u>collections</u> when I come – 1 Co.16.

"λογία, -ας, ἡ, (fr. λέγω to collect), (Vulg. collecta), a collection: of money gathered for the relief of the poor, 1 Co. 16:1 sq. (Not found in prof. auth. ...)" – Thayer, p.379

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- 1. Conclusion: two literal resurrections; 1000 year reign in between.

  [If this were only passage on subject...]
  - 2. One resurrection; no 1000 years between Jn.5:28-29
- 3. Jesus reigns now, 1 Co.15
