Steward has charge of family affairs, business, etc.

- •Gn.39:4, Joseph Potiphar
- Lk.12:42, manage household / estate
- •1 Co.4:1-2, God requires faithfulness
- •1 Pt.4:10, God's stewards

1-2: had to account for misuse of goods

- Thought he could get away with dishonesty?
- Dismissed as steward.
- Jesus uses dishonest manager to teach spiritual lesson?
 - -Mt.10:16

God can use bad men to teach good example without endorsing their evil.

3: thought about his situation

He is deceitful, but not to himself-

- 1. In possession of wealth today
- 2. Will lose it soon
- 3. Must provide for that time
- 4. Only way is to use wealth he has now He cannot dig

He is ashamed to beg

4: resolution: must act now to prepare for future

When he loses everything friends will receive him

5-7: put his plan into action

- 1. Acted quickly, 5-6.
- 2. Put great importance on securing his future. This comes first.

8: commended? WHY?

- NOT because he was dishonest.
 Ga.6:7.
- HIS lord commended him.
- BECAUSE he acted 'shrewdly' [Mt.10:16]
 - Prepared for future
 - Acted quickly

- 9: you also make friends 'by' unrighteous mammon . . .

 - a. Positive: Mt.25:31-46

- Do we bypass opportunities to do good?
- What if we worked as hard for eternal success as sinners for earthly success?
 - -1. Insurance
 - -2. Farmer
 - -3. Athlete
 - -4. Christian. Lk.13:24; 2 Co.12:15
