  - Affliction is wake-up call
  - Bitter medicine can save a life

- 1-2: faith brings peace
- 3-5, spiritual growth
  - Tribulation does not nullify assurance. 'Trouble; suffering' – Ex.4:31
  - -2: rejoice in hope makes sense.
  - -3: rejoice in tribulation -???
    - -There is purpose in it all

# Ro.5:3-5, spiritual growth

- Tribulation
- Perseverance ability to keep on keeping on.
- Character ¹test; ²result: standing a test (dross burned away)
  - After test of sufferings, result is proven character. <u>Job</u>
- Hope approved character gives us more confidence in God

# 2 Co.12:1-9, revelation

- Pain, 7: arrogance would destroy Paul
- Prayers, 8-9a, Paul asked for relief
  - Answer: 'no' something better in mind: grace to endure
    - When man can do nothing, divine power is recognized
- Purpose, 9b, boast in weakness
