- 'Many ways to heaven.'
- 'We should be tolerant.'

### Mt.7:21-23

<sup>21</sup> "Not everyone who says to Me, 'Lord, Lord,' shall enter the kingdom of heaven, but he who does the will of My Father in heaven. 22 Many will say to Me in that day, 'Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in Your name, cast out demons in Your name, and done many wonders in Your name?' <sup>23</sup> And then I will declare to them, 'I never knew you; depart from Me, you who practice lawlessness!'

### Mt.28:18

<sup>18</sup> And Jesus came and spoke to them, saying, "All <u>authority</u> has been given to Me in heaven and on earth."

## All authority – unlimited

And as soon as he knew that He belonged to Herod's jurisdiction, he sent Him to Herod, who was also in Jerusalem at that time – Lk.23:7

#### Jn.12:48

He who rejects Me, and does not receive My words, has that which judges him—the word that I have spoken will judge him in the last day.

Chain: rejection . . .

#### Gal.1:8-9

But even if we, or an angel from heaven, preach any other gospel to you than what we have preached to you, let him be accursed. As we have said before, so now I say again, if anyone preaches any other gospel to you than what you have received, let him be accursed.

One who turns from gospel [truth,
2:5] is accursed.

#### Tit.2:15

- <sup>8</sup> Speak these things, exhort, and rebuke with all authority. Let no one despise you.
- Authority: right with complete [f "Who do you think you are?"
- 'Show that you have command when you rebuke them' -L-N.
  - -Titus was not an apostle.
  - -Power resides in the Word.

#### Jude 3

<sup>8</sup> Beloved, while I was very diligent to write to you concerning our common salvation, I found it necessary to write to you exhorting you to contend earnestly for the faith which was once for all delivered to the saints.

- His final word
- Pertaining to a single occurrence and decisively unique, once and for all'

## Standard condemns churches that abandon NT pattern

- 2 Co.11:3-4, 13-15
- Pergamos, Rv.2:12-16

Critic: sword. Hb.4:12-13

Commendation: great work, 13.

Condemnation: tolerate error, 14-15.
