## 1. Young prophet, 1 K.13

- 1. Terror does not silence him, 1-5.
- 2. Temptation does not stop him, 7.
- 3. Treasure does not sway him, 7-9.
- 4. Trickery deceives him, 10-19.

## 1. Young prophet, 1 K.13 2. Pharisees, Lk.12:54-56 Lk.20:20-26

Could not distinguish two loyalties: earthly and heavenly.

Purpose: catch Jesus in error; cannot see their own. 1 Co.11:29

Young prophet, 1 K.13
Pharisees, Lk.12:54-56
**Rich man, Lk.12** Deceived by riches

1. Satisfied: knew when to leave rat race ... with satisfied soul. Prov.27:7

- 2. Smart: rich farmer ... but does not discern material / spiritual values.
- 3. Senseless: does not distinguish retirement and eternity.

Deceived by riches – rich man ...

- 1. Planned for time, not eternity.
- 2. Put money first, God last.
