Nehemiah – A Wanted Man

Bad news from Jerusalem (Neh.1:1-3)

- Great distress
- Great reproach
- Wall broken down
- Gates burned

Persia to Jerusalem (Nehemiah, 444 BC)

Far from Jerusalem in distance...

- Nehemiah had 'arrived'
- Temptation: forget 'little' people [Gn.40:23]

- Took it to Lord in prayer <u>four months!</u>
 - Chislev (1:1) . . . Nisan (2:1)
- 1:11, cupbearer to king (1:6, sins)
- 2:1-2, sad in king's presence [Est.4:2]
- 2:3, situation calls for grief
- 2:4, one last short prayer...
- 2:5-8, heart of servant help his people

 - 4:1-3 . . . 6

To pray without watching is to tempt God. To watch without praying is to slight God.

- 12: wherever turn, they are there.
- What to do?
 - 1. Watch and pray, 9. Mt.26:41.
 - 2. Precaution; protect weak spots, 13.
 - 3. At stake: all that is dear to you; God is on your side, 14.
 - 4. Keep working, 15.
 - 5. Assistance of brothers and God, 19-20.

Greed, selfishness, 5:1-5

- Lack of brotherly love.
 - Irony:

Babylonian exile: families were together

Back at home: children sold into slavery

Personal attack, 6:10-14

- Nehemiah's courage did not falter, 6:11
- Nehemiah's trust did not waver, 6:14
 - What is the worse enemies could do?
