What Is Faithfulness?

- The quality of being faithful; fidelity
 - Strict or thorough in the performance of duty
 - True to one's word, promises, or vows
 - Steady in allegiance or affection
 - Adhering or true to fact

Being A Thorough Christian

 - Serving at your best Heb 11:1-7
- Examples:
 - Jesus John 19:16-30
 - Paul 2 Tim 4:6-8
- Contrast:
 - Saul 1 Sam 15:10-23









Being A Steady Christian

- What is this type of faithfulness?
 - Being faithful til the end Rev 2:8-10
 - Remaining faithful through trials Jam 1:2-4
 - Being trustworthy and reliable Luke 16:10-12
- Examples:
 - God 1 Cor 10:12-13
- Contrast:
 - The church at Thyatira Rev 2:18-25









Adhering To The Truth

- What is this type of faithfulness?
 - Believing the gospel Acts 15:7-11
 - Making sure we aren't disqualified 2 Tim 3:1-9
 - Following earthly examples 2 Tim 3:10-11
- Examples:
 - Abraham Heb 11:17-19
 - Peter John 6:66-69
- Contrast:
 - The Jews Rom 3:1-4
