Four causes of poverty in Bible –

- 1. Calamity: includes widows, orphans ... and Egyptian famines.
- 2. Oppression: as Israel in Egypt, Ex.1-2.
- 3. Slothfulness: Prov.26:15.
- 4. Spiritual sacrifice. 2 Co.8:9; 2 Co.11:27; Ph.4:11.

13: very severe

15: die. (1 Sm.20:3)

Languished: weak, lacking vitality, wasting away

Seven years of plenty can deceive

- Take food for granted.
- Seven full years was temporary.
- Beware where we put our trust.

Four rich men

- Lk.12:16-21
- Lk.16:19-31
- Lk.18:18-23

- 1. Possess goods now.
- 2. Soon will lose all.
- 3. Must prepare for it.
- 4. Must use what have now.
- Lk.23:50-54 (Mt.27:57)

Same facts as others, but succeeded.

More concerned about kingdom of God than holding to earthly possessions.

 - Reason: world in present form is passing
 - ◊ 1 Tim.6:6-10, we need but little here below
