- Mistake, failure, error (not violation of God's law).
- Ex.9:27 And Pharaoh sent and called for Moses and Aaron, and said to them, "I have sinned this time. The Lord is righteous, and my people and I are wicked."

Work is serious

- Anything that hinders work is serious.
 - Lk.16, steward.
 - Mt.25
- Time is precious; limited supply. Ep.5:16
 - Mistakes (sins) cost time, can rob God, defeat goals
 - Bulletin mistakes cannot be as valuable as bulletin messages. Nu.13-14
 - Corrections themselves may profit. Ps.51
