- 2. People are examples of what can be done
- 3. No record of human examples is complete. Hb.11:32

- Name of Tychicus in lists of messengers of churches . . . (2 Co.8-9)
- Time: end of third preaching journey
 - Acts 24:17 . . . Acts 27-28
 - 2 Corinthians 9:16-24, highest qualities

Tychicus (Eph.6:21-22)

- 1. Reliable reporter (21).
- 2. Paul's circumstances.
- 3. Beloved (Gn.22:2; 1 Co.4:14)
- 4. Brother. Automatic bond.
- 5. Faithful. Ep.1:1, all; 6:21, Tychicus (Col.1:2, 7; 4:7...)
- 6. Minister delivered gospel to churches.
- 7. In Lord relation to Lord.
- 8. I have sent. Humility.
- 9. Comfort / Encourage, 22.

Tychicus . . . With <u>Onesimus</u> (9)

- Faithful, beloved brother one of you
- "They" will tell you what is happening
 - Epaphras was with Paul, 12; 1:7-8. Philemon 23, *fellow prisoner . . .*
- Onesimus also served Paul
- Tychicus protects Onesimus

Paul's release - journeys

- Paul at Nicopolis, sends for Titus [Crete]
 - Titus cannot leave Crete without preacher
 - Send Artemas or Tychicus?
- This shows that Tychicus is . . .
 - mature; able to go wherever Paul sends.
 - ready to incur dangers of travel (2 Co.11).
 - zealous. He never says no, or tires of work, deprivation, sacrifice.

V. 2 Timothy 4:12 Tychicus To Ephesus

Paul will soon die (2 Tim.4:6-8) Paul's concern: for brethren, not himself. Paul knows Ephesian church is in good hands with Tychicus. Implies Tychicus is . . . 1. filled with knowledge of Scripture. 2. able to teach, exhort. 2 Tim.2:2. 3. able to work with people. 4. good example (1 Tim.4:12). 5. concerned for them. 6. wise in counsel. 7. humble. 2 Tim.4:20 (Ac.20:4)

Tychicus Lessons

- 1. Pride has no place in our life.
- 2. God's word gives us what we need. able to work with people.
 - He serves as our example
 - \circ He encourages others
 - $_{\odot}$ He is always zealously working and serving
 - $_{\odot}$ He is striving for heaven
 - He can help congregations in spiritual growth

Tychicus Lessons

- 1. Pride has no place in our life.
- 2. God's word gives us what we need.
- 3. A devoted Christian. Mt.25
- 4. A willing servant. Mt.20
- 5. Not an apostle, yet became arms, legs, mouth of one who is (Paul).
- 6. Trustworthy.
- 7. Strong. Difficulties / danger did not stop him
- 8. Steadfast.

Steadfast Tychicus and Paul

- 1. Before imprisonment (Ac.20): easy times.
- 2. Paul in prison (Ephesians / Colossians).
- 3. Paul released (1 Timothy / Titus).
- 4. Paul in prison (2 Timothy).
 - Paul's lot may fall to Tychicus.
 - Tychicus stays the course.
 - Acts 20:22-25; 21:10-14
