"Me" generation – focus on themselves

What does the Bible say about "me"?

I. Glorifying God In Me, Gal.1:24

Paul's past / pardon – extreme makeover

- House ugly house becomes showplace
- Person change looks
- Behavior give up annoying habits
- Paul transforming grace
 - Lord does not destroy His enemies; converts them to His service.
 - His conversion praises God's glory.

Paul does not preach himself

- "In me" is not "on account of me"
- "In" describes the sphere in which the action takes place
- Paul does not preach himself, 2 Cor.4:5
- "Me" is a small, profitless subject
 - Ex.14:4
 - Ac.9
 - Ro.8:37

Paul does not preach himself

- BUT: "me" passages do not focus on Paul himself; emphasize what Christ did for him and in him.
- Paul did not let past sin or success hinder present duty – Ph.3:13.
- Lk.9:61-62

II. Gave Himself For Me, Gal.2:20

The sequence

- I no longer live, 20
 - I died (crucified with Christ)

He was crucified for me – salvation from sin's punishment (pardon)

I am crucified with Him – salvation from sin's power (purity)

- Ro.6:6
- Hb.12:2, shame of the cross

The sequence

- I no longer live, 20
- Christ lives in me. Ep.2:15
- I now live by faith in Son of God.
- Loved me, gave Himself for me.
 - Basis of salvation: love, sacrifice for me
 - Land me 9 times in verses 19-21

III. World Crucified To Me, Gal.6:14

The facts

- Glory: boast + cross: metonymy; paradox
 - Nothing more humiliating than cross
- When was world crucified?
 - When Paul was crucified, he sentenced 'world' to death [no common ground between Paul and world].
 - Crucifixion is torture, tactless, terminal.
- When was Paul crucified to world? 5:24
 - When he crucified its passions and desires of his flesh

It's personal

- To me: *personal*. No one can obey for me.
- To live: *practical*. Someone controls us.
- Is Christ: purposeful. My life is Christ.

Passage is not saying . . .

- Positive mental attitude gives us ability to do any job.
- Jesus gives us right to do any job.
- All have same talents.
