Walk: way of life

- Six sections of 3:16-4:16 may lead some to believe that God is not in control.
- Eccl.5 takes us to house of God for the answer.

- 1: House of God Gn.28:17, 22 Temple, 1 K.6-8 // No temple, Jn.4:24
- 1. Walk prudently (guard feet). Ps.119:101
 - -Jews, Ex.3:5. Josh.5:15
 - Lv.10, irony... Mt.15:9.
- 2. Draw near to hear... Ja.1:19-25
- 3. Avoid sacrifice of fools (1, 3, 4)
 - -Worship is sacrifice . . . Hb.13:15

4. Do not know they do evil. Hb.12:28f.

2: rash mouth

- May include . . .
 - 1) False worship. Mt.6:5
 - 2) Fruitless words (all talk, no walk) v.2; Mt.6:7-8.

3: excess business – troubled dreams; excess words – foolish speaking

 - 1. Officials are often corrupt.

9: knotty translation:

"Even a king depends on the soil"?

"A land gains when the king is committed to cultivated fields"?

Dangers:

- 1. May think more of land / profit than God.
- 2. May sink into despair and unbelief. Ps.73:16-17.

- Many wealthy actors / athletes are not satisfied.

- Key word: God
- 18: enjoy (NOT as 2:1, but 2:24). 1 Tim.6:17 a. Gift of God.
 - b. Heritage (reward, lot).
