# Words matter

- Ep.2:8
  - Grace is all that God does to save us
  - Faith is all that we do in response
- Calvinism: no conditions in salvation (not even faith)
  - What difference would it make if I obey or not?
  - Gn.6:8, Noah, grace – v.22. Hb.11:7
  - Lk.4:27, Naaman. Ep.5:26-27; Tit.3:5
