The Day Of ... Small Things

Deuteronomy 9:21

- Brook: stream that flowed from the rock
 - -Ex.17:6
 - -Ps.78:16-20
 - -Ps.105:41
- Same water that gave them life took their idol out of sight

Exodus 32, the idol

- 1: sneaked it in while Moses was away.
- 2: from earrings
- 4: image of calf?
- 8-10: people on edge of total destruction
- 20: could not save itself
- 27: death to idolaters
- 35: plagues ... a lesson for living

Deuteronomy 9:21

- Decisive break with the past
 - Is.2:18-21... some learn the hard way (1 Co.8:4)
 - -Ac.19:...18-19, the easy way
 - Sacrifice
 - Burned bridges behind them

1 Kings 19:12

- God can speak in a thunderous voice (John 12:28)
 - His small voice to Elijah must have been intentional
- Deliberate contrast with other 'great' phenomena –
 - -Great wind, 11
 - -Earthquake, 11
 - -Fire, 12
 - -Still small voice, 12

1 Kings 19:12

- The point?
 - People are converted, not by terrors / force, but by force of God's word.
 - If gospel cannot turn a person to the Lord, nothing can. Ac.13:...46.
 - -Elijah would not save Israel by terrific displays of power, but by the quiet persevering labors of God's servants.

1 Kings 19:12

 - -Mt.12:19
 - -Lk.17:20-21
- 1 K.17:13, small cake ... 18:44
 - -Small cloud, yet look at what it produced
- Col.1:23

Zechariah 4:...10

- Context: Ezra 2-6; Zech.4:6-10
 - After 70 years of Babylonian captivity, 50,000 returned to Canaan
 - Zerubbabel: political head
 - Joshua: high priest
 - Haggai and Zechariah: prophets

Zechariah 4:...10

- Context: Ezra 2-6; Zech.4:6-10
- Concern: Zechariah's eight visions were designed to set a fire under Jews who had become lax in spiritual duties
 - Started rebuilding Temple; opposition stopped them (Ezra 4)
 - Enemies mocked: Jews were discouraged
 - Jews turned to other projects: woodpaneled homes (Hag.1:4)

Zechariah 4:...10

- Context: Ezra 2-6; Zech.4:6-10
- Concern:
 - Fifth vision: Jews have despised day of small things (4:6-7, 10).
 - Zerubbabel had despised the early start
 - The project that was impossible for man was not impossible for God.

God delights in small things...

- Jochebed: small basket saved baby (Moses)
- Moses: rod delivered nation from Egypt
- Joshua: two spies in Jericho; small cord
- Samson killed 1000 Philistines with jawbone
- Jonathan and armor bearer defeated enemy
- David used small stone to fell a giant
- Handful of meal, jar of oil sustained widow
- Five barley loaves, two fish fed multitude
- Mustard seed would become great tree
- Basket saved life of Paul
