- Ezk.2:4; 3:7, 'they will not listen'
- Lk.14:28-30, self-appraisal
 - 13:4, one tower fell and killed 18
- Lk.14:31-32, self-answer
- Lk.14:33, self-action

- Ezk.13:...19, God's people listened to lies
 - 1 Chr.21:1, it can happen to the best
 - Mt.16:23-24, even Peter
 - Lord's friend was his worst foe when he would discourage Him from His life's work
 - 23, get behind Me Satan (4:10)
 - 24, disciples...come after me (23)

Take heed to yourself

Dt.4:9

- Moses' last discourse to His people
- Some were forgetful hearers, or negligent to pass it on to their children
- Summary of Deuteronomy: keep an eye on yourself

Some sin against themselves

Hab.2:10, You give shameful counsel to your house, Cutting off many peoples, And sin against your soul.

Prov.8:36, But he who sins against me wrongs his own soul; All those who hate me love death.

Come to yourself

- 1 Kings 8:47, versions
 - NASB: if they take thought...
 - ESV: yet if they turn their heart....
 - NRSV: yet if they come to their senses...
 - NIV: and if they have a change of heart.
 - NKJV: when they come to themselves in the land where they were carried captive...

Come to yourself

Lk.15:...17, came to himself

- Commonly applied to one who has been deranged
- When he recovers . . . we say he has "come to himself"

Proper attitude toward self

Ro.12:3, sober thinking

- Most judge people according to rank, money, power, influence...
- 2 Co.3:5, sound examination (1 Co.9:27)
 - Candidly
 - Consistently

Gal.6:1, consider self (3, 7-8)

Ja.1:22-25, profit from your hearing
