- Greatest foundation for spiritual children godly parents [mother and father who love each other]
 - Timothy

Why is this study so important?

- Marriage is God's plan, Gn.1-2 ... Mal.2
- Marriage reflects the relation of Christ and His church, Ep.5
- Marriage based on Scripture puts children on biblical path, Ep.6
- Marriage that neglects Scripture insults God and can hinder spread of the gospel, Hb.13:4
- Marriage that follows Scripture can encourage obedience to gospel, 1 Pt.3

In disagreement, use kind words Ps.141:3

- 1. Edify. Ep.4:29
- 2. Do not tear down. Col.3:19
 - "Embittered, irritated"
 - "Never treat them harshly" NRSV
 - Do not be rude, cruel, or unkind

Always make sure your words are sweet; you never know which ones you'll have to eat.

Communicate

- Wife assumes husband knows what she needs... 1 Co.2:11
- Husband assumes worst about wife...
 1 Pt.3:7
- Be careful with criticism
 - Job 16:1-5; 19:1-2

Always be 'good-looking' 2 Sm.6:16-23, Michal 1 Co.13:7

Don't expect / demand perfection

Do not be afraid of loving a spouse too much

- Ep.5:25
- Tit.2:4

Keep a sense of humor

- Don't take yourself too seriously
- Pr.5:18, Let your fountain be blessed, and rejoice in the wife of your youth

Thirteen Rules For Happy Marriage (1/2)

- 1. Never both be angry at once
- 2. Never yell at each other unless house is on fire
- 3. Remember: it takes two to argue
- 4. Yield to wishes of the other if possible
- 5. If you have a choice, make mate look good
- 6. If you must criticize, do so lovingly

- 7. Beware getting historical
- 8. Neglect the whole world rather than spouse
- 9. Never let day end without compliments
- 10. Never meet without affection
- 11. When you make a mistake, admit it
- 12. Never go to bed angry
