Num.13 – giants are fearful

Cannot compare with God.

All spies saw same giants...

Two are eager to conquer

Ten are afraid

Ten perished

Two survived...they lived by faith

Cowardice insults God

Josh.1:9 – do not be afraid...

Had the giants shrunk? ...died out?

Had the Canaanites moved out?

Had Canaanites converted to Judaism?

Had Canaanites destroyed their weapons?

Mt.8:26 – faith chokes fear.

2. Fear God, not fear

Dan.3:16-18 – greatest king on earth

Lk.12:4-5 – public proclamations (3) may cost lives... Disobedience and apostasy cost *eternal* life

Hb.10:31 – Omnipotent, eternal, and just...
