Penitential psalms: Ps.6, 32, 38, 51, 102, 130, 143

Ps.32 = Ps.51, but later

Ps.32:1-2, beatitudes (= 1:1)

I. Psalm 32

Sin, 1-2, 5

Four pictures: the burden of guilt

- 1. Transgression: 1 (5): rebellion; flouting God's will.
- 2. Sin: 1 (5): turning from right path to disobedience. Miss, misstep, slip.
- 3. Iniquity: 2 (5): evil, perverted, twisted, disrespects God.
- 4. Deceit: mislead, treachery.

Honestly confesses his sin (5)

Salvation, 1-2, 5

Three pictures: the blessings of forgiveness

- 1. Forgiven: 1 (5): lift, bear, take away...
- 2. Covered: out of sight, out of mind. 2 K.5.
 - Ark covering is mercy seat (Ro.3:25; Hb.9:5)
 - Includes forgiveness: turning away God's wrath
- 3. Not imputed: He does not take it to account. Ro.4:7-8. Debt cancelled.

Suffering, 3-4 David's autobiography – 2 Sm.11

- 1. Bones grew old, 3. 6:2. Pr.17:22.
- 2. Groaned all day, 3.
- 3. Hand heavy upon Him, 4. 1 Sm.5:11. Jn.10:29.
- 4. Vitality drought, 4. Dry bones...

II. Principles

- 1. If your sins are forgiven, thank God
 - -"Blessed" (1-2). "O how happy"
- 2. Closer we get to God, better we see sin
- 3. Guilt is good when it drives us to Christ
- 4. Only God can hide sins (blot out). Pr.28:13.
- 5. Denial of guilt adds sin to sin. 2 K.5.
- 6. Confession is good for the soul.
- 7. Salvation demands urgency. Tit.3:14
- 8. God: the most frightening enemy. Ja.4:4

Conclusion – we must learn to . . .

- Acknowledge what sin is. Jer.17:9
- Ascertain the seriousness of sin.
- Accept responsibility for sin (confess).
- Abandon sin (repent).
- Adore the God of our salvation.
